Evidence Necessary For Means Assessment For Legal Aid

If you are living with a partner you must bring the same evidence as listed below for that person as well:

Income: (tick if received)

- 1. Benefit letters i.e. letter (all pages) confirming you are in receipt of Income-based Jobseekers Allowance, Income-related Employment And Support Allowance, Income Support or Guarantee Credit. Housing Benefit. Council Tax Benefit.
- 2. All bank statements showing all of your income and transactions from the day before your meeting to one month previous.
- 3. Most recent Tax Credit Award Notice (all pages) for yourself. (Within six months)
- 4. Copy payslip(s) for the four weeks prior to your appointment.
- 5. If self-employed complete financial accounts recently submitted to the Tax Office, last six months bank statements, self-assessment tax return & cash book.
- 6. P11D tax form if applicable.
- 7. Private/occupational pension documents.
- 8. Evidence of rental income (bank statement or tenancy agreement).
- 9. Letter evidencing income or finances from a friend/family.
- 10. Student grant/loan letter.

Expenditure: (tick if received)

- 1. Rent book/tenancy agreement.
- 2. Mortgage statement.
- 3. Bank statements.
- 4. Copy of agreement/contract if childcare costs are in excess of £600 per month.
- 5. If maintenance paid, receipts & copy of Maintenance Order.

Capital: (tick if received)

- 1. Bank statements showing all of your income for the calendar month prior to your appointment.
- 2. Current valuation of any properties owned including family home by either estate agents or via internet i.e. rightmove, zoopla or any other recognised sites.
- 3. Investments (i.e. share certificates, premium bonds, national savings certificates/passbook, insurance policies & any information on possessions e.g. caravan, boat, and jewellery).
